The Bike Walk Roll Summit is a three-day event we've hosted annually since 2015, bringing together communities across Washington including Spokane, Olympia, and Tacoma.

The Summit attracts 150–200 attendees from diverse sectors. Participants include state and local planners, engineers, elected officials, and community advocates.

#### **Program Structure**
